Oxfordshire has a very good population of pigeons and our hunters had very good results in 2011. Oxfordshire is a classical English farmland. Large open fields with hedgerows and small woods. An ideal biotope for wood pigeons.

The number of pigeons obviously varies a lot from week to week. The hunting result is always depending on weather, wind, crops and the shooting abilities of the hunters.

Hunting takes place in different fields (rape, barley, peas and

beans) and on stubble, depending on where the pigeons are in the period concerned.

Before the arrival of the hunters, the guide will make strong efforts to find out where the best conditions are for a good shooting.

Some rabbit shooting can also be arranged.

Accommodation takes place in a local pub and includes breakfast.

The district takes hunters both in the spring and from mid July in to September.
