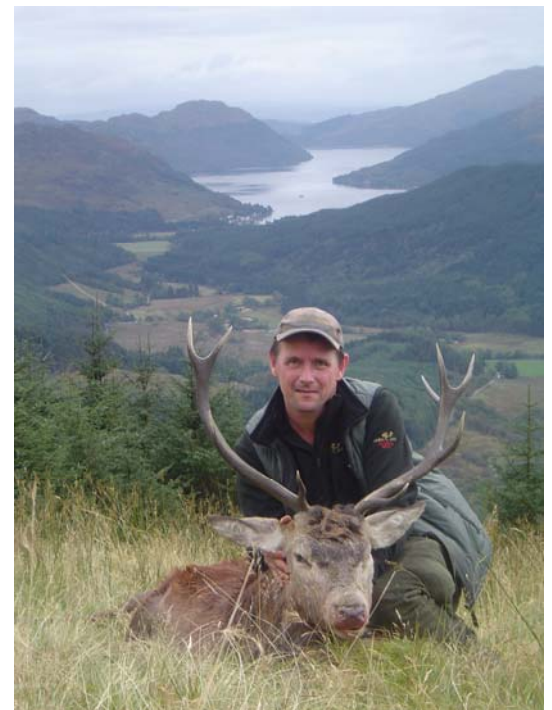
## STAG- AND ROEBUCK STALKING ON YOUR OWN

### COWAL – Stag Stalking – Roebuck Hunting

The year 2012 is our 23rd season with our popular non-guided hunting arrangements for roebucks in the spring and in the summer months and for stags in September and October.

The Cowal peninsula lies west of Glasgow in the south-western part of Scotland. The hunt takes place in forest areas, which is administrated by one of the largest private British forest companies. Our districts in this area are rather hilly and it can therefore be a rather strenuous hunt where you must be prepared to work hard.

Some areas consist of plantations and older woods. Others are young plantations and areas with cut down trees and some are



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a mixture of both.

A larger part of the young plantations is enclosed with a fence without having any decisive effect on the hunt.

The arrangement includes 4½ days hunting, from Monday morning till Friday noon. On arrival one of the gamekeepers in the area will brief you about the hunt and show you the district.

Considering how difficult a hunt in a quite unknown area can be and how inexperienced some of the hunters have been, we are impressed by the results that our hunters have achieved during the last couple of years. Each hunter bagged approx. 2 stags on average. Also, several roebucks were bagged on the stag hunts. Of course, we cannot give any guarantees for a result but we can offer a hunt quite on your own in a wonderful nature.

As mentioned above most of our hunters succeeded in bagging games on their hunts. Some did not succeed for some reason or another, but these are the conditions and if they are not acceptable, it's better to consider a guided hunting. As mentioned before we neither can nor will give any guarantees for a result. The skills of the hunters are very different and DIANA therefore cannot accept any complaints about lack of bag, if any.

It's important to mention that we have had many hunters who have been on these hunts several times. These are hunters, of course, who like the challenge of stalking on their own.



Accommodation takes place in typical Scottish houses as close to the district as possible. Some districts, however, are rather scattered, which means that it can be necessary with some driving to get there. It's on a self-catering basis and it will always be possible to do some shopping. There are also cosy pubs or restaurants close by.
